The new Student Fees Regulations (Tuition Regulations) for the academic year 2017/2018 have been posted on the website of the Academy.

The main changes for Italian students are the following:

- **The tuition free range** (exemption from tuition fees) for students with ISEE forms declaring incomes below **€14,000.00**.
- **10 new tuition brackets** (tuition fees ranging from €70.00 to €1,550.00) ranking students with ISEE forms declaring incomes ranging from **€14,000.00 to €40,000.00**.
- One installment payment for tuition fees under **€300.00** and two installment payments for tuition fees above **€300.00**.
- **€1,800.00** is the tuition fee for students with ISEE forms declaring income above **€40,000.00** and for students who **do not present ISEE forms**.

The admissions office strongly urges all students who wish to be eligible for a reduction in tuition fees to submit ISEE forms together with applications. ISEE forms will not be accepted after application deadlines.

Main deadlines:

- First year students who are exempt from the entrance exam: enrollment deadline – **31st August, 2017**.
- First year students that are required to take the entrance exam: enrollment deadline – **7 days** after the publication of the exam results.
- Students already attending the Academy: enrollment deadline – **30th September, 2017**.

PLEASE NOTE: students who wish to **defend their thesis during the February/March 2018** session are encouraged to submit their ISEE forms as soon as possible. If they are not able to graduate within that period, their enrollment deadline for the 2017/2018 academic year is **31st March, 2018**. At that point, they should submit their ISEE forms in order to be eligible for tuition reduction.

The new Student Fees Regulations (Tuition Regulations) for the academic year 2017/2018 have been posted on the website of the Academy.

The main changes for international students are the following:

- Tuition requirements have not changed for international students already enrolled for the 2016/2017 academic year, but the minimum tuition fee has been raised from **€300.00 to €500.00**.
The tuition fee for students who do not present ISEE (ECONOMIC SITUATION DECLARATION) forms is €1,800.00.
- First year international students who wish to enroll in 2017/2018 (bachelor's and master's levels) **are not required to submit ISEE forms** but must submit **documents from their countries of origin** as indicated in article 5 of the Academy Regulations. The tuition fee for students who fail to present proper documentation is €1,800.00.
- International students from **developing countries** (see the list in the Academy Regulations) **are not required** to submit ISEE forms and pay a flat rate tuition fee of **€500.00**.

The admissions office strongly urges all international students who wish to be eligible for a reduction in tuition fees to submit ISEE forms (for students who have already completed one year at the Academy) or alternative documentation (for first year students) together with their applications. ISEE forms will not be accepted after application deadlines.

Main deadlines:

- First year students who are exempt from the entrance exam: enrollment deadline – **31st August, 2017**.
- First year students that are required to take the entrance exam: enrollment deadline – **7 days** after the publication of the exam results and **payment within 10 days** after the communication of the tuition fees (if they have been calculated by the admissions office).
- Students already attending the Academy: enrollment deadline – **30th September, 2017**.

PLEASE NOTE: students who wish to **defend their thesis during the February/March 2018 session** are encouraged to submit their ISEE forms as soon as possible. If they are not able to graduate within that period, their enrollment deadline for 2017/2018 is **31st March, 2018**. At that point, they should submit their ISEE forms in order to be eligible for a reduction in tuition fees.
